

**List of measures to implement Regulation (EU) 98/2013 on explosives precursors in the EU/EEA**

<b>Austria</b>	Ordinance (Ausgangsstoffverordnung BGBl II Nr. 31/2015) established a registration regime for three substances.
<b>Belgium</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Bulgaria</b>	A ban is in place. Decree № 283 of 29.12.2015 lays down rules.
<b>Croatia</b>	The Law on the implementation of Regulation EU 98/2013 (Narodne novine broj: 41/2016 02.05.2016) established a licensing regime for three substances.
<b>Cyprus</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Czech Republic</b>	ACT No. 259/ 2014 Coll. established a combined registration and licensing regime.
<b>Denmark</b>	Act no. 1623 of 26 December 2013 and Order no. 956 of 28 August 2014 maintained a pre-existing licensing regime.
<b>Estonia</b>	A ban is in place. The Chemicals Act of 29.10.2015 lays down rules.
<b>Finland</b>	Law 653/2014 established a licensing regime.
<b>France</b>	Law 2016-731 of 3 June 2016 established a registration regime.
<b>Germany</b>	A pre-existing registration regime under the Chemicals Prohibition Ordinance (ChemVerbotsV) is in place.
<b>Greece</b>	A ban is in place. The Joint Ministerial Decision . reg.no 23056/ΔTBN 464/( Gazet. Off. 687 B' 16.3.2016) lays down rules on penalties.
<b>Hungary</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Ireland</b>	Statutory Instrument No. 611 of 2014 established a licensing regime.
<b>Italy</b>	A ban is in place. Rules on penalties are laid down by L. 17 April 2015, n. 43 (Gazet. Off. 20 April 2015, n. 91.)
<b>Latvia</b>	A ban is in place. Rules on penalties are laid down in the Criminal Law and the Latvian Administrative Infringements Code.
<b>Lithuania</b>	Measures have been adopted which establish a registration regime.
<b>Luxembourg</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Malta</b>	L.N. 359 of 2014 Product Safety Act (Cap. 427) established a combined registration and licensing regime for three substances.
<b>Netherlands</b>	The Law on explosives precursors established a licensing regime.
<b>Norway</b>	A ban is in place. Regulation 588 of 2 June 2015 lays down rules.
<b>Poland</b>	A ban is in place. Law of 13 April 2016 on the safety of trading in explosives precursors lays down rules.
<b>Portugal</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Romania</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Slovakia</b>	Act 262 of 10 September 2014 established a registration regime for three substances.
<b>Slovenia</b>	A ban is in place. Decree No. 28/2016 of 15.04.2016 lays down rules.
<b>Spain</b>	A ban is in place.
<b>Sweden</b>	Lag (2014:799) om sprängämnesprekursorer established a licensing regime for three substances.
<b>United Kingdom</b>	Poisons Act 1972 [as amended] and Statutory Rule No. 224 of 2014 (for Northern Ireland) established a licensing regime.
